News items / Issues

- **Youth facilities:** This project has already gained £3000 of funding from the South Somerset District forum. Individuals are invited to help form a steering group is still urgently needed.
- **Community Safety campaign:** This will take place in Spring 2012 and include publication of an 8-page newsletter.
- **Speed Watch:** Several members have volunteered to help with this. After initial enquiries it appears that Speed Watch is not applicable in 20 mph zones. However, the chair has seen one in action at the 20 mph zone in Tollard Royal (Wiltshire). We expect to clarify this and progress to organising training soon.
- **Speed Humps:** There remain serious concerns about the smoothing of speed humps in Stiby Road. They are no longer a deterrent to speeding and residents often witness aggressive driving.
